AIR BRAKE ENDORSEMENT - CODE 15

Driving large trucks, buses, and even some RVs equipped with air brakes require that drivers achieve the Air Brake Endorsement (code 15) on their class 5 or 7N licence. ICBC dictates that prior to adding an Air Brake Endorsement to your licence, individuals must take a 7 hour Air Brake Course at an approved Driver Training facility like Valley Driving School. Drivers must also successfully complete a computerized knowledge test at ICBC and pass a practical certification test, either with ICBC or a certified driving school. Save yourself the trip to ICBC and study, train, and complete the air brake certification test with us!

This program includes:

7 hours - Air brake theory course

4 hours - Air brake certification

AIR BRAKE THEORY COURSE

This interactive 7 hour classroom provides students with the correct information to successfully prepare for the ICBC Air Brake knowledge test which is a requirement of upgrading to a commercial licence. Once students have completed this course, most go to an ICBC Driver Licensing Office and take the Air Brake knowledge test paired with the class 2 or class 3 knowledge test.

HOUSE TRAILER ENDORSEMENT - CODE 7

The province of BC allows drivers to tow a fully-loaded recreational house trailer weighing up to 4,600 kg Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) with a two axle vehicle like a pick-up truck, with a regular drivers licence. If your fully-loaded recreational house trailer exceeds 4600 kg, you'll need to upgrade your licence to include a House Trailer Endorsement (code 7). Should your trailer or vehicle have air brakes, you'll need to upgrade to a class 1 licence with an Air Brake Endorsement (code 15).

HEAVY TRAILER ENDORSEMENT - CODE 20

Towing a trailer with a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) over 4,600 kg requires drivers to upgrade their current licence to include a Heavy Trailer Endorsement (code 20). A code 20 endorsement allows drivers to tow trailers of any weight appropriate for the tow vehicle, provided that neither the trailer or tow vehicle are equipped with air brakes. Should your trailer or vehicle have air brakes, you will need to upgrade to a class 1 licence with an Air Brake Endorsement (code 15).
